I. PURPOSE:

Senior FFA members explain their accomplishments in FFA and their knowledge of current agriculture issues.

II. OVERVIEW:

Students will be able to:

1. Conduct a professional interview
2. Effectively create a professional resume
3. Explain issues and accomplishments thoroughly

III. GUIDELINES:

1. An applicant for this award must be classified as a senior in an Indiana Public School at the time of the application for this award. The applicant must be an applicant for, or already have received the Hoosier FFA Degree at the time of application for this award.
2. To enter the district Leadership Ambassador Contest, the candidates must submit the following items to the District President:
 - a. High School Transcript
 - b. Updated State FFA Degree
 - c. Professional Resume-*one page*
 - d. FFA Resume-*proficiency style resume-2 pages*
3. Each chapter is entitled to enter one female and one male contestant into the district contest. One female and one male District FFA Leadership Ambassador winner will be entered for competition for the State FFA Leadership Ambassador contest at the State FFA Convention.
4. Candidates will be asked questions in regard to their participation in:
 - a. Supervised Agricultural Experience Program
 - b. FFA Chapter Activities
 - c. Agricultural Education Class Activities
 - d. School Activities
 - e. Community Activities
5. Contestants will also be asked three questions in each of the following areas:
 - a. Agricultural Knowledge
 - b. FFA Knowledge
 - c. Current Events Awareness
