

DISCOVERY DEGREE DEMONSTRATION

CAREER DEVELOPMENT EVENT

Discovery Degree Members may only participate in one of the three Discovery Degree Leadership CDE's per year.

I. OBJECTIVE:

1. Research various areas of agriculture to effectively develop an educational demonstration
2. Efficiently demonstrate knowledge in specific agriculture areas.
3. Teach agriculture skills in a step-by -step process.
4. Build upon public speaking skills.

II. GENERAL EVENT OVERVIEWS:

1. The demonstration will be presented by a maximum of two students and include any agriculturally related area.
2. Demonstrations shall not exceed 8 minutes. There will be a point deduction of 1 point for the first 30 seconds over the designated demonstration time and then 1 point for every 15 seconds thereafter. There will be 3 minutes at the conclusion of the demonstrations for judges to ask the students questions related to their demonstration topic.
3. Professionally prepared demonstration and visual materials should not be used. All original materials must be prepared by the student. The use of live animals is prohibited.
4. Each demonstrator will be responsible for providing his/her own materials and equipment to carry out the demonstration.
5. Official dress is not required for the discovery degree demonstration, however business attire is required.
