

# **Exhibit**

## **DESCRIPTION**

FFA members work together to produce an exhibit to highlight their chapter's local, state, and national FFA programs and inform the community of their presence.

## **OBJECTIVE**

Students will be able to:

1. Effectively work together to produce an object to benefit the chapter they represent.
2. See how well-produced public relations tools can be of benefit to them.
3. Utilize the exhibit as a public relations display in the school and community.

## **GUIDELINES**

1. The exhibit must follow the current National and/or State FFA theme.
2. The exhibit displayed must be an original exhibit.
3. The exhibit must not be more than four feet deep, six feet long, and six and a half feet tall. (If it is displayed on a table then the table height is included also.)
4. The state exhibit entry must be in the exhibit room on the contest day of state convention and removed by the last day of convention.
5. Moving parts and multi-media capabilities can be included in exhibits. Exhibits should be useful and portable.
